### **2.1 Visa**

### 2.2 Identity Card

Before travelling to Germany you need to have a current identity card if you are in the European Community otherwise you need a passport.

# 2.3 Further entry requirements

Advice for travelling by car:

- 1. blood alcohol limit while driving a car:
  - a. people under the age of 21 are prohibited to have any blood alcohol limit
  - b. all the other people are *allowed* to have a blood alcohol limit of 0,3 per mill, but you can still get into trouble, please don't drink and drive
- 2. speed limit:
  - a. city limit 50km/h if not marked otherwise
  - b. country road 100km/h if not marked otherwise
  - c. Autobahn no limit if not marked otherwise
- 3. it is necessary to be in possession of a valid driver license
  - a. either an international driver license or
  - b. a German driver license

### Health:

No vaccinations are required for entry into Germany.

It is recommended to travel with international health insurance.

- 1. fire department/ambulance: 112
- 2. police: 110
